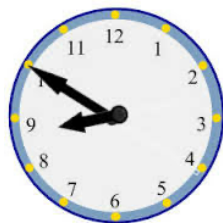

Notes from the Headteacher's Study

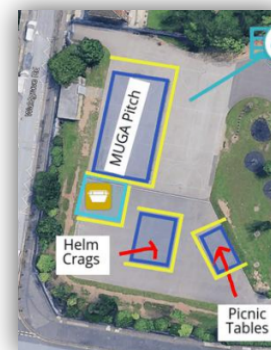
Excitement on the Playground!

Smart uniform 'King's Northway Team Kit'

Children at Northway work so hard to wear full uniform, be smart and take pride in their King's Northway badge. This, linked to excellent attendance shows their **smart attitude** for learning. **Smart appearance** benefits an attitude of **smart learning**.



All **long hair** tied back neatly. Hair is a personal choice but should not detract from studying or distract others.

Any **hair accessories** in **School colours** **Blue / White / Gold / Yellow** (no flowers, bridesmaid style headbands or Jala-bows in bright colours – just blue)

Jewellery is not needed but if children have ears pierced, they should be studs. **Watches** are permitted that are not connected to a phone.

PE and Sports

Children wear the white King's Northway polo shirt with any **blue or black shorts**. Children can wear **blue / black joggers** or sports leggings when outdoors for PE.

Please ensure **trainers / pumps** are available for PE. All kit should be kept in the King's Northway PE Bag, left in school and taken home for washing during half term.



We have an optional **blazer** that can be worn if children wish. These can be ordered through school.

Please label ALL items with your child's name. It helps return uniform using our Lost Property Process quickly.

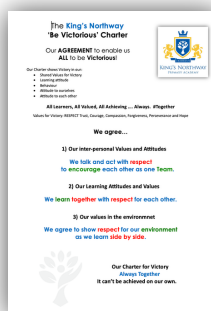
